6. Before the start of the event, **a competitor must produce his or her student pass** to the Call Room Judges for verification of age. Failure to do so may result in the disqualification of the athlete.

7. SPECIAL TECHNICAL MATTERS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 7.1 The SPH Schools Relay Championships shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the International Association of Athletics Federations (IAAF) and the Singapore Athletic Association (SAA).

- 7.2 **Scoring** : The winner of each relay event will score eight (8) points, The second will score seven (7) points, and so on.

- 7.3 **Ties** : In the event that two or more teams gained the same number of points in the competition, the tie shall be decided in favour of the team with the greater number of first places and if necessary, to subsequent placing until the tie is reduced.

- 7.4 If there is a tie in any event, the combined points of the teams so tying shall be divided.

8. ALLOCATION OF LANES

The allocation of lanes for all events for all rounds shall be drawn by the Organising Committee.

9. AWARDS

- 9.1 Medals : The winner, the second and third of each event shall receive medals.

- 9.2 Trophies: Challenge Trophies shall be awarded to teams in the respective categories scoring the most number of points

- 9.3 One (1) Championships Overall Challenge Trophy will be awarded

- 9.4 One (1) Tay Cheng Khoo Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the Most Outstanding Relay Team

10. FINAL PROVISIONS

All matters not provided by these Regulations shall be submitted to the Organising Committee of the Singapore Athletic Association for decision.
