COMPETITION RULES & REGULATION – STADIUM RUN

1. Rules

- 1.1 According to the Rules established by the latest rules and regulations and as directed by the Singapore Athletics Association
- 1.2 Governed by the Pesta Sukan 2019 General Rules and Regulations.

2. Eligibility & Registration

Permanent resident and foreigner are welcome to participate with a condition of he/she have a residential address here.

3. Event Venue & Schedule

4. Participants

The Stadium Run it's an individual event. During the event date, participant can come and collect their bibs within the running period in the morning. There will not be any flag off for this run. Participants can cross the start line and proceed to complete their run around the stadium based on their category.

5. Competition Format

- 5.1 The tentative race distance for all the categories stated above
- 5.2 A runner can only register for one category.

- 5.3 Participants can collect a RFID Tag and run at their own time; they are required to run over mats or a detection system so that their timing is automatically recorded
- 5.4 Participants will be allow to **re-challenge**, if they so wish to run again to better their previous time. Participants who re-challenge are only allowed to a **one-time redemption** of the Gold/Silver/Bronze souvenir.
- 5.5 Each category will have a Gold, Silver and Bronze time, please refer to the time:

6. Prizes

- 6.1 All runners will get an event tee for participating, finisher with Gold, silver and bronze timing will get different souvenir.
- 6.2 Event tee sizes and souvenir for Gold, silver and bronze will be given on the first come-first-serve basis. Once size and souvenir is finish for a particular category, you can choose the next available option.
- 6.2 Cash Prizes will also be given to top **one** individual position in each category.

7. Disqualification

- 7.1 Participant who did not run the required number of rounds of his/her category will be disqualified. Disqualified participant is able to re-challenge his/her attempt again on the following week.

8. Equipment and Attire

- 8.1 All participants will be given a bib number which they must display clearly on the front of their vests.

9. Reporting

- 9.1 The participants shall submit their participants' identity cards and collect their bibs and proceed to the start line to run.
- 9.2 All participants must bring along his/her valid Singapore pink or blue identity cards, valid driving license (with photo) or valid passport for verification, failing which he/she will not be allowed to compete in the championship.

10 Dispute

- 10.1 In the event of any dispute arising over any participant, the run shall be played under protest and the Organisers shall determine the matter on receipt of the protest.

11 Competition Jurisdiction

- 11.1 The Organisers reserve the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of this Stadium Run at any time. Notifications of such changes will be posted on the games website. All participants are advised to visit the games website for any notices or updates.
- 11.2 While reasonable precautions will be taken, the Organisers, their servants and agents will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this tournament.
